## Example Question (example currently on FAQ page)

#### **Question 4:**

Can you address how proposers should account for the potential 4 month gap between selection and receipt of funding? Will the five year clock start upon receipt of funding?

There is no "official" 5 year clock. Section 4.4.2 and requirement J-12 of the EVI-1 PEA states that "Each selected investigation under the EVI solicitation will be expected to deliver an instrument that can be integrated onto a selected platform by September 30, 2017." Each proposal will need to demonstrate they can meet this requirement.
